



## **FITTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR LP0021BK TAIL TIDY (LICENCE PLATE HOLDER)**

### **Kawasaki ER-6 up to 2008**

**Please note that the way the kit is packed does not necessarily represent the way of mounting to the bike**

- NOTE YOU WILL NEED TO GLUE THE LIGHT SHROUD TO THE LED LICENCE PLATE LIGHT BEFORE FITTING USING SUPER GLUE.
- Remove seat
- Undo wiring loom to number plate light & flashers
- Undo the 4 nuts holding the tail unit to the bike & remove tail unit
- Take the R&G licence plate holder & fit to the bike using the 2 rubber spacers and the 4 nylon nuts supplied & tighten
- Fit the led number plate light and the indicators of your choice. If you use after market indicators use the blanking plates supplied.
- Reconnect wiring
- Note we suggest that you cut the plug from your original number plate light and connect it to the LED light supplied using the two splice connectors in the kit.

**If you plan to fit mini indicators to the rear of the bike only (not the front), you will need to source and fit your own resistor, in order to reduce the wattage.**

### Conseil de montage:

Enlever la selle.

Défaire le faisceau de la lumière de plaque

Démonter les 4 vis tenant le support de plaque et enlever le support d'origine

Positionner ensuite le support de plaque R&G sur la moto, en utilisant les deux pièces en caoutchouc, les 4 vis M6x30 et les écrous autobloquants livrés dans le kit

Mettre les clignotants de votre choix sur le support de plaque, si vous utilisez des clignotants adaptables, vous devrez mettre deux pièces en alu de chaque côté sur les emplacements des clignotants d'origine.

Reconnecter les faisceaux électriques

Nous vous suggérons de couper la prise de la lumière de plaque d'origine et de connecter la lumière R&G à l'aide des deux connecteurs rouges livrés dans le kit.

**Die Verpackung der Teile stellt nicht die Reihenfolge der Montage dar.**

- HINWEIS: VOR DER MONTAGE MUSS DIE LICHTABDECKUNG MIT SEKUNDENKLEBER AN DER LED-KENNZEICHENBELEUCHTUNG ANGEKLEBT WERDEN
- Entfernen Sie den Sitz.
- Lösen Sie die Kabel zur Kennzeichenbeleuchtung und zu den Blinkern.
- Lösen Sie die 4 Mutter, die den Kennzeichenhalter am Motorrad befestigen und entfernen Sie den Kennzeichenhalter.
- Montieren Sie den R&G Kennzeichenhalter am Motorrad – verwenden Sie die 2 Gummi-Distanzhalter und die 4 selbstsichernden Mutter vom Kit.
- Montieren Sie die LED-Kennzeichenbeleuchtung und die Blinker Ihrer Wahl. Wenn Sie Zubehör-Blinker montieren, benutzen Sie die mitgelieferten Verschlussstreifen.
- Verbinden Sie die Kabel wieder.
- Hinweis: Wir empfehlen, den Steckverbinder von der Originalkennzeichenbeleuchtung abzutrennen und mittels der mitgelieferten Kabelverbinder mit der LED-Beleuchtung zu verbinden.

**Wenn Sie Mini-Blinker hinten (auf keinen Fall vorne) montieren möchten, werden Sie einen Widerstand brauchen (nicht in Lieferumfang enthalten), um die Wattleistung zu reduzieren.**
