

Fitting Instructions for RAD0162BK Radiator Guard KAWASAKI ZX6R '03-'04



In This Kit There Should Be
1x Radiator Guard (RAD0162BK)
2x Cable Tie
2x 100mm Lengths of self-adhesive Foam

TOOLS REQUIRED

- Socket set to include 3, 4 & 5mm A/F & 10mm socket & wrench.
 - Cable cutters.

FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

- To fit the radiator guard to the bike cut the foam strip provided into 10mm wide pieces and stick them to the back of the radiator guard frame, so that they sit between the radiator guard and the radiator.
- Remove the left side fairing from the bike, as shown in picture 1.
- With the fairing removed, access can be gained to the lower radiator mounting bolt on the left side of the bike in front of the exhaust headers, as shown in picture 2. This bolt can now be removed.
- Offer the R&G Radiator Guard into place on the bike, ensuring that the bracket on the bottom aligns with the lower radiator mount and the top of the radiator guard sits behind the horn, before re-fitting the original bolt in the bottom mount, as shown in picture 3.



- Position one cable tie through the upper mounting holes on the left side of the radiator and loop around the top radiator / frame mount, as shown in picture 3, 4 & 5. Once in place, tighten the cable tie.
- Repeat the above stage on the upper mount for the other side of the bike.
- With both cable ties tightened and the original lower bolt tightened, the radiator guard should now be securely located in place.
- Re-fit the fairing to the left side of the bike.

Outils requis

- Jeu de clés 3, 4 & 5mm & 10mm.
- Pince à couper (pour les colliers).

Instructions de montage

- Couper la mousse en bandeaux de 10mm puis collez ces bandeaux au bas du support de protection radiateur, de façon à ce que ces bandeaux se situent entre la protection radiateur et le radiateur.
- Enlever le carénage coté gauche de la moto (Photo 1).
- Une fois le carénage enlevé, l'accès est possible pour le boulon de fixation radiateur du bas du coté gauche de la moto, devant les collecteurs d'échappement (Photo 2). Ce boulon peut à présent être enlevé.



- Mettre la grille de protection R&G en place sur la moto, en veillant à ce que le support sur le bas s'aligne avec le support radiateur du bas et que le haut de la grille de protection se place derrière le klaxon, avant de remettre le boulon d'origine sur le support du bas (Photo 3).
- Poser un collier à travers les trous de la fixation supérieure du coté gauche du radiateur et enrouler le support radiateur / cadre supérieur (Photo 3, 4 & 5). Une fois en place, serrer les colliers de fixation.
- Répéter l'étape précédente sur le support supérieur de l'autre coté de la moto.
- Avec 2 colliers de fixation serrés et le boulon inférieur d'origine fixé, la grille de protection radiateur peut maintenant être correctement fixée en place.
- Remettre le carénage du coté gauche de la moto.

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
