

# Fitting Instructions for RAD0128BK/TI Radiator Guard KTM 990 SM 2007- and 990 SMR 2012



In This Kit There Should Be 1x Radiator Guard (RAD0128BK) 2x 100mm Lengths of self-adhesive Foam

- To fit the radiator guard to the bike cut the foam strip provided into 10mm wide pieces and stick them to the back of the radiator guard frame, so that they sit between the radiator guard and the radiator.
- Remove the two upper radiator-mounting bolts in position arrowed in pictures 1 and 2.
- Undo and remove the lower radiator-mounting bolt arrowed in picture 3.
- Offer the radiator guard into position (it may be easier for installation to remove the front fender) and use the original bolts to secure the guard and radiator into position as original.

<u>Le kit doit contenir :</u>
1x Protection radiateur (RAD0128BK)
2x 100mm Mousse autocollante

- Couper la mousse en bandeaux de 10mm puis collez-les au bas du cadre de protection radiateur de façon à ce qu'ils se retrouvent entre le radiateur et la protection.
- Enlever les 2 boulons supérieurs de fixation en position indiquée en photos 1 et 2.
- Enlever le boulon inférieur de support radiateur (photo 3).
- Mettre la protection en position (Il serait plus simple de l'installer en enlevant le garde boue avant) et utiliser les boulons d'origine pour fixer la protection et le radiateur en position d'origine.



## Montageanleitung für den RAD0128BK/TI Kühlerschutz KTM 990 SM 2007- und 990 SMR 2012



<u>Dieser Kit beinhaltet</u>: 1x Kühlerschutz (RAD0128BK) 2x 100mm selbstklebende Schaumstoffstreifen









- Um den Kühlerschutz am Motorrad zu montieren, schneiden Sie zuerst die mitgelieferten Schaumstoff-Streifen in 10 mm breiten Streifen und kleben Sie die auf der Rückseite des Kühlerschutzrahmens, so dass sie zwischen dem Kühlerschutz und dem Kühler angebracht sind.
- Entfernen Sie die zwei oberen Montagbolzen am Kühler, die auf den Abbildungen 1 und 2 markiert sind.
- Lösen und entfernen Sie den untern Montagebolzen am Kühler, der in Abbildung 3 markiert ist.
- Den Kühlerschutz in Position bringen (dieser Schritt wird vereinfacht, wenn Sie das vordere Schutzblech entfernen) und den Kühlerschutz und den Kühler mit den Originalbolzen wie ursprünglich befestigen.
