

FITTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR CP0200BL CRASH PROTECTORS CAGIVA MITO 125



Please note that the way the kit is packed does not necessarily represent the way of mounting to the bike

Please note that in cases where kits are packed with rubber washers holding the components onto the bolt – *the rubber washers should be thrown away*!

Left-hand side (as you sit on bike)

- Remove lower fairing as shown above left
- Remove the engine bolts arrowed above left
- Replace with new block from kit as above right using M8 cap head screw in lower hole only.
- Place the longest M8 cap head bolt in top hole and paint end with paint or tippex
- Replace fairing and mark inner face with paint from bolt head
- Remove fairing and painted bolt (for marking purposes only)
- Drill pilot hole from inside face
- Replace fairing and check alignment with hole
- Only when satisfied the hole is in the correct position carry on
- Drill from outside face of fairing using 28mm hole saw deburr using a sharp knife
- Replace fairing and connect indicator wiring.
- Place the washer onto the hex head bolt and feed through bobbin
- Fit bobbin assembly through fairing into top hole of bock and tighten bolt until you feel some compression from inside the protector. Turn a little more so that you feel the compression increase slightly. Then apply a quarter turn. Do not overtighten as damage can occur to the bike. Do not exceed 40nm of torque.



Right-hand side (as you sit on bike)

• Repeat above procedure for the opposite side.

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
